# PRESIDENT'S REPORT

## SPRING

Last Year, the adult riders wanted to make sure that the kids were having success at the penning game, so we were allowing them to pen 2 right and 1 wrong cow. It has been decided that the Jr Youth have shown improvement over last year and are now ready to pen 3 right cows. The adult riders contribute immensely on these issues and we appreciate their input.

It seems the weather has caused too many delays in the completion of the arena in Sundre. Anne Thompson who is the operator for that show is looking for alternatives and we will keep you posted.

As mentioned in a previous penner, the fees for Regional Finals will go up from \$35 - \$50 per entry. Saddles will be given out to high point teams in each class and \$15,000.00 added money for payouts. It should be noted that the increase fees is in response to increasing financial pressures on the Association. If there is, at anytime, excess funds available, they will be distributed to the members.

Rick Dalton has resigned from the Chinook Board of Directors. Rick has been a great asset to both the Chinook and Canadian Associations in soliciting sponsorship money. His contributions will be greatly missed. We wish Rick continued success with all of his endeavors.

This leaves a considerable void in the area of sponsorship. The present system has Chinook Association receiving 38% of the sponsorship money collected. Rick Dalton did a great job in achieving the current level of sponsorship funds. In 2003 the Chinook will be responsible for its own sponsorship so it is crucial that we start a sponsorship committee immediately. The association needs the money to support the level of penning we are accustomed to.

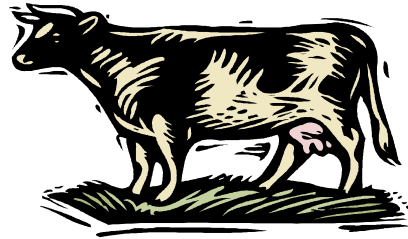

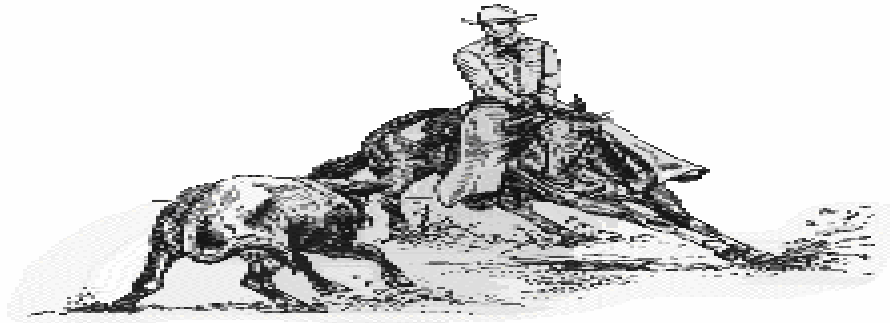
