## President's Report

The start of the 2003-penning season is fast approaching. Twelve shows were finalized for this year, down two from last year. There is a possibility that another show might be held in July. We will let you know if this is arranged. A show schedule is included in this penner. Six shows are needed to qualify for Nationals, eight shows to qualify for Regional Finals, and year end points will come from a rider or team's best 10 shows.

As most of you already know, the CTCPA brought in 3 new rule changes this year.

If a wrong cow goes into the pen, the team will receive a "no time".

The hand must be above the shoulder to call for time.

The foul line can be at 50% or 60% of the arena.

There are changes in the Chinook Association also, which were voted in at the Annual General Meeting.

The time limit in the Open and #10 classes is now 60 seconds. The time limit in all other classes remains the same.

There will be a Limited Open Class, which will run within the Open class. Information about this class is included in the penner.

The entry fees will be increasing by \$1.00 per entry. Some show operators requested an increase and the Board settled with them on an increase of \$2.00 per team. The other \$1.00 will go to increased payout. The breakdown of the entry fees is as follows:

Entries must be in by 6 PM on the Tuesday prior to the show. Late entries will be allowed up to 1/2 hour before the class is run, if there is sufficient cattle. A team or member may cancel their entry up to two days prior to the penning. Last year there was a problem at one show with teams entered that did not show up and did not cancel by the deadline. This cost the Chinook Association \$800. If notification is not received and the team or member is a no show for any reason at the penning, the team or member will now be responsible for fees owing in the amount of \$30.00(\$10.00 per rider). The show operator will receive \$25.00 and the Chinook \$5.00 from the fees. Unpaid fees must be paid before the member or team will be allowed to compete in future pennings.

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# Chinook Team Penning Assoc.

## Limited Open

The limited open class was voted in at the Chinook Team Penning AGM in September of 2002 to run on a trial basis , in an effort to increase payout by increasing the number of entries in the open class.

The Limited open class is:

A # 12 Class run within the open class.

All riders are eligible to compete ( riders # 1-#6)

Riders will now have the opportunity to ride 4 times in the Open/Limited Open,

However, at least one of the 4 rides must be either a Limited Open team or an Open team.

Examples: If you are entered in the Open/Limited Open 4 times:

3 Open teams & 1 Limited Open team

2 Open teams & 2 Limited Open teams

1 Open team & 3 Limited Open teams

**LIMITED OPEN TEAMS MUST BE DESIGNATED AT TIME OF ENTRY!**

Cost \$10.00 per person, \$30.00 per team.

This cost is in addition to regular Open team entries.

The \$30.00/team entry will be 100% payout for Limited Open teams only.

Suggested Payout for 1 to 10 teams

1<sup>st</sup> 70%

2<sup>nd</sup> 30%

Suggested Payout for 11-25+ teams

1<sup>st</sup> 50%

2<sup>nd</sup> 30%

3<sup>rd</sup> 20%

# Around the Hitching Ring.....

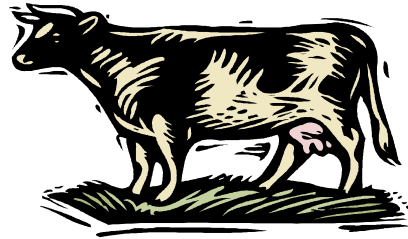
- Anyone interested in sponsorship please see or call Pat Wierzba 938-5251

- For year end points, the best 10 shows are counted.
- For registration, there are 2 forms to be completed. One is for the Chinook Team Penning Association, and the other is for the Canadian Team Cattle Penning Association. **2 different cheques must be made out to the appropriate associations and must be accompanied by the correct forms.**
- Points may be affected if teams keep being double entered! Please take care in entering the teams as double entries take more time in data entry and confuses the computer (and the people inputting)!
- Unknowns on a team must be filled with a name 1/2 hour before the class starts.
- Penners, could you please use your team number and names when entering? This will help with the entries.

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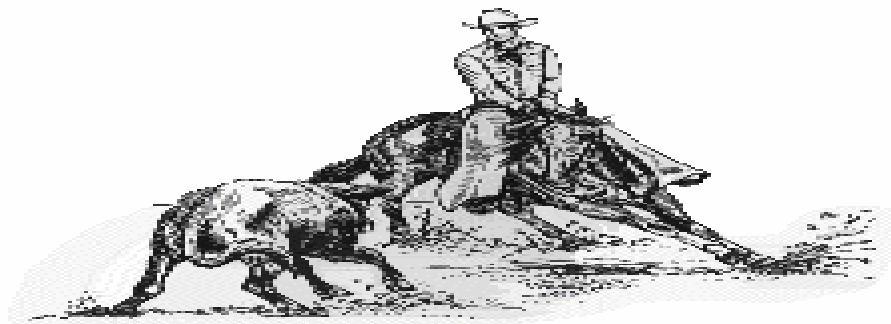
